



ADVANCE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Eastern Analytical Symposium & Exposition

November 13 - 15, 2017



The 2017 EAS Advance Registration materials consist of three (3) pages. This page contains detailed instructions and information concerning registration, and should be carefully read prior to completing the registration process. If you are an invited speaker, contributed speaker, session chair, short course instructor, booth personnel for an exhibiting company or EAS Governing Board Member, please refer to the registration information which you have been sent.

1. There are three methods which you may use to register in advance for the 2017 EAS. These methods are Paper Copy, Fax Copy, and Electronic Registration via our web site. Registration using our web site is the preferred method; however, paper copy and fax are also acceptable. If you utilize the web site registration, you will receive an immediate confirmation of your registration via e-mail.

A. If you wish to register electronically via our web site, please access the EAS Home Page at www.EAS.org, and follow the instructions provided for registration. Please provide the necessary credit card information. Forms submitted without the proper credit card information will not be processed.

B. If you wish to register using the fax copy method, please complete the third page of the registration form and **fax the form to EAS Registration at CompuSystems, 708-344-4444**. In order to register by fax, you must pay for your registration by credit card. Please make sure that all credit card information is complete and legible prior to faxing the form. Forms faxed without complete credit card information will not be processed. They will be faxed back to you for completion and re-submittal. You will receive a confirmation of your registration via e-mail (e-mail address is the preferred method) or via fax (if you provide a valid fax number). If you do not provide either of these, your confirmation will be sent via U.S. Mail.

C. If you wish to register using the Paper Copy Method, please complete the third page of the registration form, and send the form by U.S. Mail to:

Be certain to include a check, money order, or complete the credit card information on the form. You will receive a

confirmation of your registration via e-mail (if you provide an e-mail address), fax (if you provide a fax number), or by U.S. Mail.

2. Please register using only one method. This will reduce your chances of being registered and charged more than once for your registration.
3. Payment must accompany your registration at the time it is received. If you will be paying by corporate or personal check, you cannot register electronically or by fax. Registrations received without payment will not be processed.
4. Eastern Analytical Symposium does not accept purchase orders.
5. If you register for an "Exhibit Only" registration, you may not visit the Technical Sessions, or register for EAS Short Courses. You may visit the Exhibit Area, Employment Bureau, and Poster Area, and you will receive an EAS Souvenir.
6. If you register for a "Full Conferee" registration, you may visit the Technical Sessions, Exhibit Area, Employment Bureau, and Poster Area. You will receive an EAS Souvenir and you may register for EAS Short Courses (at additional cost).
7. If you are registering for a "Student" registration, you are entitled to the same privileges as a "Full Conferee", but at a reduced cost. Please provide a copy of your student identification with your registration or be prepared to show your student identification when you come to the meeting.
8. The fees for EAS Short Courses are in addition to the "Full Conferee" or "Student" registration fees. You must pay the "Full Conferee" or "Student" registration fee to take the short course. In other words, someone registering **in advance** for a two-day EAS Short Course would pay \$850 for the course and \$225 for the "Full Conferee" registration, for a total of \$1,075. If you are registering for more than one course you only need to pay the "Full Conferee" or "Student" registration fee once.
9. Advance registrations must be postmarked (or faxed or e-mailed) by October 1, 2017 in order to be processed at the "Before October 1" rate. Registrations postmarked (or faxed or e-mailed) after that date will be charged the "After October 1" rates.
10. Registrations are non-transferable, and are for one person only. There will be a \$25 fee for replacement badges.
11. All registration cancellations are subject to a \$25 processing charge. The deadline to cancel your registration and receive a refund is November 1, 2017. Your cancellation and request for refund must be received in writing.
12. No badges for the 2017 EAS will be mailed out prior to the meeting. Please retrieve your badge at the EAS Registration Area in the Crowne Plaza Princeton Conference Center.
