- The best quality separations possible.
- Final trim of booklet is 8 ½ " by 11". Copy should not exceed 7 ½ " wide by 10" high. If advertisement will bleed, image must be 8 ¾ " by 11 ¼ " (1/8" trim on each side).
- Artwork Image Sizes:
 - Full page 7 ½ " wide by 10" high
 - 2/3 page 5" wide by 9 ¼ " high
 - 1/2 page horizontal 7 ½ " wide by 5" high
 - 1/3 page horizontal 7 ½ " wide by 3" high
